MR. MEAGHER: Good afternoon. My name is Joseph Meagher and I am counsel to the Broome County Industrial Development Agency. The Agency is conducting a hearing pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 859A to seek public comment on an application for financial assistance submitted by ADEC Solutions USA, Inc., in connection with the proposed document management facility to be located at 56 Broome Corporate Parkway in the Town of Conklin.

The acceptance of the filing by the Agency does not infer any position on the approval or disapproval of the financial assistance requested. No position will be taken by the Agency until the public hearing is concluded.

I will first ask Kevin McLaughlin,

Executive Director of the Agency, to explain
the benefits that have been requested by

ADEC Solutions USA, Inc.

MR. McLAUGHLIN: Thank you, Joe.

The project entails the acquisition and rehabilitation of 56 Broome Corporate Parkway by ADEC Solutions USA.

ADEC Solutions is a global business process outsourcing company with offices throughout the world including United Kingdom, Australia, Singapore and the Philippines, to name a few. Their clients include companies in the fields of healthcare, banking, media and entertainment, aerospace, legal, human resources and housing.

Initially, the 56 Broome Corporate Parkway site will serve as a center for document management solutions including scanning and archiving services.

The company expects to hire 133 employees in the next two years with expectations of

growing to over 250 in three to five years. The total project cost for the project, including acquisition of the building, is estimated at \$920,000.

The BC -- the Agency will be considering approving a standard 15-year PILOT for the company including sales and management tax exemptions.
