Pacemaker Steel, through a closelyheld entity of BNGO Realty, LLC, has a contract to purchase an existing warehouse at 172 Broad Avenue in the City of

Binghamton. The building is approximately 47,685 square feet. Pacemaker Steel has an existing manufacturing facility at 2 North Floral Avenue in Binghamton. It will continue to operate that facility while expanding into the 172 Broad Avenue location.

Acquiring the new location will allow Pacemaker to add product, offering added value, services, and expand existing product lines, which will allow them to expand their current sales territory for the east and south and expand the customer base.

The expansion is projected to create five jobs, but more importantly, Pacemaker's continuing to make a significant investment in Binghamton and Broome County. This investment shows a commitment to continued operations long term in the county.

The company is seeking a standard 15year PILOT that will freeze existing taxes
for five years. In years six through ten
any tax increase over the frozen level will
be abated by 50 percent. And in years
eleven through fifteen 25 percent. The

The Facility will be initially owned, operated and/or managed by the Company.

The Agency will acquire title to or a leasehold interest in the Facility and lease the Facility to the Company. At the end of the lease term, the Agency's interest in the Facility and Equipment will be reconveyed to the Company. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance to the Company in the form of the issuance of an abatement of real property taxes consistent with the policies of the Agency.

A copy of the Company's application to the Agency will be available for review, during regular business hours, at the Agency's offices at 60 Hawley Street, Binghamton, New York 13901.

A representative of the Agency will, at the above-stated time and place, hear and accept written comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the proposed financial assistance to the Company or the location or nature of the Facility.

Minutes of the hearing will be made available to the County Executive of the County of Broome.
