MR. MEAGHER: Good afternoon. I'm Joseph Meagher, general counsel to the Broome County Industrial Development Agency. We're holding a hearing today pursuant to the General Municipal Law on the application of Polymar Housing SPE, LLC, and We'll Do It Live SPE, LLC, for financial assistance in connection with the renovation of a housing tower for assisted -- not assisted living, excuse me, but Section 8 Housing Assistance Program of 148 units; and in connection with this we're going to take comments from the public, if available, for that purpose. taking of comments does not infer any position by the agency on this application. A transcript of this hearing will be provided to the members of the Broome County Industrial Development Agency for consideration in making a determination on the application.

At this time I'm going to ask Kevin McLaughlin, who's the executive director of

the agency, to speak and explain the application before the agency. Thank you.

MR. McLAUGHLIN: Thank you, Joe.

My name is Kevin McLaughlin, I am the executive director of the Broome County

Industrial Development Agency. Polymar Housing SPE, LLC, is seeking a 20-year PILOT on the property located at 21-23 Exchange Street in Binghamton. This is an extension of an already existing PILOT on the facility.

The property is 11 story, 148 unit apartment complex designated strictly for elderly residents and is subject to a Section 8 Housing Assistance Program certificate. The building's gross square footage is 131,774 square feet with 147 of the units with a square footage of 600 square feet and one unit measuring 900 square feet. Additionally, there is a commercial kitchen for resident use, a large dining room and various other common area amenities throughout the property.

The new PILOT schedule, which is

included in the application, increases taxes from \$148,602 to \$211,667 over the 20-year period. The owners have also agreed to spend \$1 Million over the next 10 years in capital improvements to the facility. A listing of those improvements is also included in the application.

The extended 20-year PILOT and the proposed public improvements will allow this building to continue as vital housing for senior citizens in the City of Binghamton and throughout Broome County. Thank you.

MR. MEAGHER: Thank you, Kevin.

Does anyone wish to be heard either for or

against the application?

(Whereupon there was no response)

MR. MEAGHER: Hearing none, I'm going to call this hearing to a conclusion, and I'm going to ask that the following be be spread upon the record of these proceedings.
