Buckingham Manufacturing Co., has been operation in Binghamton, New York since 1896 and is a vital employer in Broome County.

Buckingham plans to purchase 72 Grossett Drive in Kirkwood for the purpose of expanding its operation. Besides the acquisition of the property, the company attempts to do complete renovation to the facility.

The total project is estimated at

\$1,370,000 and the company expects to create 30 new full-time positions over a three-year period. The company is seeking a 20-year deviated pilot and the sales tax exemption on the purchase of materials.

The Supervisor of the Town of Kirkwood and the Town Board approved the deviated pilot and is in support of this project.
