159 Washington Holding LLC, a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, (the "Company") has requested that the Agency assist in the financing of the acquisition, renovation, and equipping of 20,000+/- square feet within the building located on a 0.17+/- acre parcel of land situate at 159 Washington Street in the City of Binghamton, Broome County, New York (the "Land") to be used as 27 one and two bedroom apartments marketed to young professionals working in downtown Binghamton, New York and any other directly or indirectly related activities (the "Facility") and the acquisition and installation in the Facility of certain equipment (the "Equipment"). The Land, the Facility and the Equipment are hereinafter, collectively, the "Project". The Project will be initially owned, operated and/or managed by the Company.

The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in the Project from the Company and lease the Project back to the Company.
