My name is Joseph Meagher and I am general counsel to the Broome County Industrial

Development Agency. The Agency is conducting a hearing this evening pursuant to General Municipal Law 859A to seek public comment on an application for financial assistance submitted by the 159 Washington Holding LLC, in connection with the proposed apartment building consisting of 27, one-and two-bedroom apartments to be marketed to young professionals working in the City of Binghamton, Broome County, New York.

The acceptance of the filing by the Agency is not for any position on the approval or disapproval of the financial assistance requested. No position will be taken by the Agency until the public hearing is concluded. Notice of this hearing was published in the Press & Sun Bulletin on March 31, 2020.

I request that each person wishing to speak, state his or her name and if you

are speaking on behalf of an entity or organization, please identify that entity or organization. The hearing will remain open until all public comment is conducted.

First, I will ask Stacey Duncan, executive director of the Agency, to explain the tax benefits that have been requested by 159 Washington Holding LLC.

Stacey.

MS. DUNCAN: Yep. I'm going to make sure I am not muted, correct? Okay. Thank you, Joe.

The Agency of the Broome County IDA has an application for developer Josh Bishop, owner of 159 Washington Holding LLC. The benefits allow for region exemption sale tax, and use tax exemption for a project at 159 Washington Street in Binghamton.

As mentioned, the project will include renovation and equipping of 20,000 +/- square feet within a building located on a 0.17 +/- acre parcel of land situated at 159 Washington Street in the City of Binghamton, Broome County, New York to be

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used as 27 one and two bedroom apartments marketed to young professionals. The total investment in the project is \$1.6 Million for the renovations of the facility and provide full time employment of three jobs and is seeking a pilot from the IDA, which requires -- which does not require municipal approval, but the city has been aware of this project and is seeking a ten-year exception of \$325,000 and, as such, will receive a three-year freeze of the existing tax level.

And that is the information that we have and we will consider for the approval of this.
