Bluestone Wind, LLC, a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, (the "Company") has requested that the Agency assist in the financing of the acquisition of the Company's fee, leasehold, and easement interests in certain parcels of land located in the Towns of Sanford and Windsor in the County of Broome and State of New York (collectively, the "Land") to be used, collectively, as a wind-powered electric generating facility, and any other directly or indirectly related activities, (the "Facility") and the acquisition and installation in the Facility of certain equipment (the "Equipment"). The Land, the Facility and the Equipment are hereinafter, collectively, the "Project". The Project will be initially owned, operated and/or managed by the Company.

The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in the Project from the Company and lease the Project back to the Company. At the end of the lease term, the Agency's interest in the Project will be reconveyed to the Company. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance to the Company in the form of the issuance of exemptions from sales and use taxes, mortgage taxes, and an abatement of real property taxes deviating from the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy.

A representative of the Agency will, at the above-stated time and place, hear comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the proposed financial assistance to the Company or the location or nature of the Project.
