- 8. The Agency/LDC has established a non-refundable application fee of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars to cover the anticipated costs of processing this application. A check or money order payable to the Agency/LDC must accompany each application. THIS APPLICATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE CORPORATION UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY THE APPLICATION FEE.
- 9. The Agency/**LDC** has established a project fee for each project in which the Corporation participates. THIS PROJECT FEE of 1% of the total Project cost IS REQUIRED TO BE PAID BY THE APPLICANT AT OR PRIOR TO THE GRANTING OF ANY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BY THE AGENCY/**LDC**. THE APPLICANT IS REQUIRED TO PAY THE AGENCY/**LDC** FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000) DOLLARS OF THE PROJECT FEE WITHIN 7 DAYS OF THE APPROVAL OF THE PROJECT. PLEASE NOTE THIS FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE. The applicant will also be expected to pay to the Agency/**LDC** all actual costs incurred in connection with the application including all costs incurred by general counsel and bond counsel.
- 10. The Agency/LDC will charge annually an administrative fee of \$1,500 to cover ongoing compliance and oversight; the fee shall be payable January 1 of each year until all financing documents shall terminate and be discharged and satisfied.

Local General Contractor, Subcontractor, Trades and Labor Policy

It is the goal of the Agency/**LDC** (the Corporation) to maximize the use of local labor for each project that receives benefits from the Agency. This policy applies to general contractors, subcontractors, trade professionals, and their employees. An Applicant will not be deficient if the proposed project utilizes parts and supplies assembled elsewhere because no such assembly is available in the Local Labor Area.
